Terms and conditions

- The competition is open to all students pursuing pre-university courses (for example, including those in Malaysia currently enrolled in A level, STPM, UEC, international schools, foundations and other pre-university programmes) worldwide, and also to students at earlier stages of their education.
- 2. Only one entry per student is permitted.
- 3. Essays must be written entirely by the student.
- 4. Entries to the competition must be unique (i.e. not published elsewhere or submitted to another essay competition) and original in content. Entries found to contain plagiarism will not be considered. A list of references acknowledging the source of any existing work you have referred to in your essay is required. - 5. Entries must be written in English, and should not exceed 1,000 words (excluding figures, tables, and references).
- 6. Essays should be submitted attached (in .doc or .docx or .pdf format) to an email addressed to: sobac@nottingham.edu.my
- 7. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed entry form signed by the author.
- 8. The deadline for submission of essays is Friday 26 August 2016. Late submissions will not be considered.
- 9. The competition judges will comprise members of academic staff in the School of Biosciences at UNMC.
- 10. The organiser reserves the right not to award any or all of the prizes and shall own the copyright to the entries.
