The Ministry of Higher Education, in its continuous effort to improve higher education in Malaysia, requires all graduating students to participate in the <u>Tracer Study 2014</u>. This is an online survey.

Tracer Study is an avenue the Ministry uses to gather the opinions and feedback from students to help them in the future planning and improvement of our education system. This information is also used to evaluate and rank institutions of higher education in Malaysia through the SETARA ranking system.

When the first SETARA ranking was out in 2009, the University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus (UNMC) was a top runner in the Tier 5 category achieving the highest score amongst other institutions and we would like move into Tier 6 (the highest rank), establishing ourselves as a top notch University. Being listed as a Tier 6 institution will further establish UNMC as a world class university in Malaysia. In the SETARA 2011 ranking, UNMC has further maintained its Tier 5 ranking due to the effort taken by the students to complete the Tracer Study.

This ONLINE exercise is COMPULSORY. You are expected to answer the all questions. Upon completion, kindly print a copy of the survey confirmation slip and submit the slip together with your graduation regsitration form to the Graduation Office.

You will need to log-in using your I/C number for Malaysian students and Passport number for International students. As for institution type, we are known as IPTS (Private Institution) and choose the University of Nottingham Malaysia Campus as your institution name. Once logged in, you will be able to answer all the questions as required and this <u>must be done until completion</u>.

As a gentle reminder, your failure to complete the survey forms will consequently delay your registration process and time is of essence as the graduation is in February 2014.
