# Prize Terms and Conditions – VC Global Graduate Prize

You must read and agree to these terms and conditions before submitting a nomination.

### **Eligibility**

- 1. To apply for the VC Global Graduate prize you must:
  - Be a registered student studying at a UK, Kuala Lumpur Malaysia or Ningbo China campus.
  - Have passed 2 Nottingham Advantage Award modules by the end of the shortlisting period.
  - Not have previously won either an Employer supported prize or the VC prize.
  - Satisfy any additional criteria for individual prizes outlined on Workspace.
- 2. If, after applying, you cease to be a registered student you must inform the Award team on your respective campus immediately.
- 3. You must submit your prize application/s before the application deadline\*. Any applications received after this time will be discarded.
- You must be able to attend an interview via videoconference in March\*. Further information about interviews will be sent to shortlisted candidates.
- 5. Highly commended and prize winners are required to attend a photography session scheduled in March\*.

- 6. If you are a student in the UK you must be able to attend the Celebration Event in June\* to collect the prize certificate.
  - Arrangements for students studying at Ningbo, China or Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia campuses will be made separately for the collection of prize certificates and any photography shoots for marketing materials.

#### **Additional Information**

- We reserve the right to substitute the prize if necessary. If this happens applicants for the prize will be informed.
- 2. There is no cash alternative unless specified.
- 3. For students studying at the UK campus only: You can apply for up to two prizes. However you can only be shortlisted for one prize. If you submit more than one application, the shortlisting panel will consider each application on its merit.
- 4. Interview feedback is given, on request, at the discretion of the panel. Feedback is not normally given about applications.
- 5. Each year we produce case studies to showcase these prizes and conduct marketing and publicity activities. You may be contacted and asked to provide quotes and/or photographs.
