Programme costs

The six-day programme will cost 400 USD. An early bird discount of 10% will be given if the full fee is paid by 30 May 2018.

The cost includes:

- all tuition and classroom support costs
- accommodation on campus for the duration of the programme
- cultural and social programme
- food during trips which are organised by the University and inclusive in the package

The cost does not include:

- return ticket to Malaysia
- food (which is very reasonably priced in Malaysia)
- accommodation and transportation for additional stay/excursions
- insurance (students coming from abroad need to sort out their own overseas travel insurance before they leave their home country)

Entry requirements

While no formal academic requirements are necessary, we welcome high school students at Year 11 and 12 (15 years old and above) with good English language proficiency of at least IELTS 5.5. Other English language certificates will be considered. You can either be a student from Malaysia or from an international school abroad.

An international outlook

Nottingham is an international institution with links in business, industry and education that reach around the world. The University has students from over 150 countries and two international campuses, one in China and one in Malaysia. The Malaysia Campus opened in 2000 and became the first branch campus of a British university in Malaysia and one of the first anywhere in the world. Nottingham was also the first foreign university to establish a campus in China when it opened in Ningbo in 2004. Both campuses are integral parts of the University and provide strong links between the UK and Asia.

University of Nottingham Malaysia

Nottingham Malaysia is a world-class institution providing a unique opportunity to gain a UK degree whilst studying in Malaysia. It is a full and integral part of the University of Nottingham, UK. All teaching, assessments and examinations are carried out in English.

The campus is a self-contained, self-sufficient village which overlooks scenic green hills. The range of on-campus facilities includes state-of-the-art laboratories, 24-hour computer access and an extensive library. There is also a book shop, convenience stores and a health centre. The Student Association has an indoor and outdoor food court, as well as social and learning hubs to relax around campus. There are also opportunities to get involved in clubs, societies and a range of activities in our recently refurbished sports centre.

The University is a hive of intellectual and multi-cultural interaction with around 5,000 students from over 85 countries.

Academic classes

Below is an outline of the classes offered during the summer school. You will need to select the classes from one of the faculties below. No prior knowledge of the subject is required. The interactive classes are taught by experienced academics and you will have the chance to use our state-of-the-art research facilities.

Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences

Businesses today are in very dynamic environment and one place where they get money to do business is the stock market. So what is investment and stock trading? Have you ever wondered what investors actually do? Find out more about how financial markets function and learn about the stock trading process via a financial trading room at Nottingham University Business School Malaysia (NUBS). The trading room at NUBS will give you real-life exposure to the discipline of investment analysis using trading simulation software.

Faculty of Engineering

Learn and think as an engineer would do when creating a better environment from a sustainability perspective. The interactive hands-on activities organised by the various disciplines in our Faculty of Engineering (chemical and environmental; civil; electrical and electronic; mechanical, materials and manufacturing) will enhance your innovation skills and influence your future career choices. You will experience the challenges encountered by engineers and how to overcome challenges with proper design approaches.

Faculty of Science

You will get the chance to learn about the research activities within our faculty and see our state-of-the-art laboratory facilities. You will also get to take part in some hands-on demonstrations, which could include:

- biomedical sciences – looking at disease under a microscope
- computer science – explore how to create your own app
- psychology – peek into psychology and learn how our mind can play tricks on us

There will also be many other types of scientific activities and demonstrations.

Social and cultural programme

As well as giving you a taste of the most up-to-date teaching and research, the programme offers social and cultural activities which will take you away from the classroom. These activities are the highlight of the International High School Summer Programme and will give you the chance to spend time with fellow students while exploring the local area. Activities will include:

- a tour of Kuala Lumpur and the surrounding area, including a photo session in Kuala Lumpur city centre
