Terms and conditions

1. The competition is open to all students pursuing pre-university courses (for example, including those in Malaysia currently enrolled in A level, STPM, UEC, international schools, foundations and other pre-university programmes) worldwide, and also to students at earlier stages of their education.
2. Only one entry per student is permitted.
3. Essays must be written entirely by the student.
4. Entries to the competition must be unique (i.e. not published elsewhere or submitted to another essay competition) and original in content. Entries found to contain plagiarism will not be considered. A list of references acknowledging the source of any existing work you have referred to in your essay is required. 5. Entries must be written in English, and should not exceed 1,000 words (excluding figures, tables, and references).
6. Essays should be submitted attached (in .doc or .docx or .pdf format) to an email addressed to: sobac@nottingham.edu.my
7. All submissions must be accompanied by a completed entry form signed by the author.
8. The deadline for submission of essays is Friday 26 August 2016. Late submissions will not be considered.
9. The competition judges will comprise members of academic staff in the School of Biosciences at UNMC.
10. The organiser reserves the right not to award any or all of the prizes and shall own the copyright to the entries.
