

Rolling CfP for ECRN's Brown Bag Research Seminars

The Early Career Research Network (ECRN) runs 'Brown Bag' Research Seminars every Autumn semester. The series gives early-career researchers the opportunity to present their research in a short 15 minute slot in front of a friendly audience. We understand that presenting your work for the first (and even 2nd and 3rd...!) time(s) can be nerve-wracking, but our seminars provide a welcoming and supportive environment that aims to help you hone your presentation skills for use in more high-pressure situations such as conferences.

Anyone interested presenting in a Brown Bag seminar should submit a 200 word abstract on any aspect of their research – from literature review to research design to results/findings. The abstract should be emailed to ECRN@nottingham.edu.my. Once received, the abstract will be sent to a friendly reviewer from a member of the UNMC academic staff for perusal. Selected presenters will then be contacted to arrange a suitable presentation slot on the ECRN Autumn calendar of events.

The angle of the paper to be presented is entirely flexible and could focus on elements of your research proposal, thesis/dissertation such as the literature review, your methodological or analytical approach, a conceptual or theoretical framework you have used or developed and/or your findings. Your paper should be delivered orally; should be 15 minutes long and may draw upon visual aids as desired (such as PowerPoint, photographs or videos).

Please do take this chance to share your research, build your public speaking skills and confidence, and network with your fellow PGRs and early career staff members!
