

PLANNING EFFECTIVE LESSONS USING THE SIOP MODEL By Associate Professor Lee Kean Wah

Planning effective lessons requires certain level of knowledge and skills. Typically, many novice teachers encounter difficulties in doing as they lacked the requisite knowledge and skills. Experienced educators at the same time are also constantly looking out for effective ways to help them succeed in their classroom and beyond.

This workshop attempts to fill the gap by introducing student teachers to a popular research-based (and validated) model of sheltered instruction that has been widely used across the U.S. for over 15 years. The sheltered model, aka SIOP model, has proven to be effective in helping teachers plan and deliver lessons that allow their students (particualrly Englsih learners) to acquire academic knowledge as they develop English language proficiency.

The workshop is designed with the following aims:

- 1. Examine what the SIOP model is
- 2. Discuss the eight components of the SIOP model
- 3. Plan and design a lesson based on the SIOP Model.
