**Prof. Gan Suyin** is currently a Professor in Chemical Engineering at UNM and works in a wide range of interdisciplinary experimental and computational activities within the central theme of energy and fuels. With over 90 publications to date, she has led several projects which are funded by government organisations, industry and university and has established collaborations with various local and international partners. She also serves on the editorial board of two international journals.

**Dr. Ho Weang Kee** is an Associate Professor in Statistics at UNM. She completed her PhD at Newcastle University (UK) and was then appointed to a post-doctoral position as a Genetic Statistician at University of Cambridge where she worked on genetic and biomarkers for cardiovascular disease. She was awarded the L'Oréal-UNESCO for Women in Science Fellowship for her work in developing a risk prediction model for breast cancer.

**Dr. Wong Ee Phin** is an Assistant Professor at the School of Environmental and Geographical Sciences. She has done her PhD under MEME (Management and Ecology of Malaysian Elephants). She is a conservation scholar alumnus and has done her research on non-invasive monitoring of stress in wild Asian elephants. She has worked with WWF as an assistant coordinator of the Wildlife Conservation Society. She is the founder of Sustainability Research Network in UNM.
