2.	Provide tailored research supervision and academic mentorship to research students at all levels, including guiding them in designing, conducting, and reporting rigorous educational research appropriate to their stage of development while maintaining high scholarly standards.
3.	Conduct rigorous and high-impact research in TESOL and cognate fields, including leading or collaborating in the process of research funding application, producing peer-reviewed publications and other relevant research outputs, and fostering local and international research collaborations.
4.	Implement and complete administrative duties and any other related tasks in a timely, proactive manner that advances the School's and/or the university's objectives.
5.	Demonstrate measurable progress in professional development through enhanced subject expertise, refined research methodologies, and improved pedagogical practices throughout the appointment.
6.	Demonstrate professional integrity through independent and consistent ethics compliance, and responsiveness to institutional communications and updates (e.g., emails, requests, meetings, training) within agreed/reasonable timeframes; proactively resolving issues within their remit before escalation; and documenting and transitioning work appropriately before absences.
