Purpose of role:	To lead the Creative Arts pathway and contribute to other teaching as necessary as well as admin roles.

The Department is keen to appoint a leader for the **Creative Arts pathway within the BA (Hons) International Communications Studies degree** in ways that add to the current staff expertise so that it will be well-equipped to respond to the demands of the expanding undergraduate and postgraduate degree programmes with students from Malaysia and the region.

The successful candidate will hold a M.A or PhD degree, or equivalent qualification, be a **specialist in diverse creative arts spanning performance, writing, production and have online links to recordings of performances** and have impressive publications of their works. Candidates will be expected to take contribute to the teaching of Humanities at undergraduate level and to contribute to the teaching and further development of the pathway. Candidates will be expected to liaise with the Division of International Communications at the University of Nottingham in Ningbo, China, to assist in the planning and introduction of programmes in Cultural Studies on the University's UK campus, and to undertake, when appropriate, supervision of students in this important area.

Candidates will also be expected to be **actively involved in grant applications**. Candidates will also be expected to have developed a **research career and artistic projects** which will help develop the Department's research profile.

This position is at the level of **Assistant Professor** in Performing Arts/Cultural Studies /Media and Communications and includes both administrative and teaching responsibilities.
