Who is this programme for?

Entry requirements

While no formal academic requirements are necessary, we welcome high school students, Malaysian or international, aged 16 years and above with the following level of English language proficiency:

The Leading Edge (CEFR** B2 or IELTS 5.0)

You will be required to complete an online test after you have sent in your application to determine your CEFR** level. Those who choose to enter below the recommended language levels are likely to find the programmes challenging.

Students will be accepted on a first-come first-served basis which is based on the availability of places.

** CEFR is the Common European Framework of Reference.
