

Welcome to the University of Nottingham Malaysia

Congratulations on your offer to study at the University of Nottingham Malaysia. This flyer will guide you through the <u>next steps</u> needed to make your arrival at the University as smooth as possible.

Your offer

There are two main types of offer:

- conditional
- unconditional

A **conditional offer** enables you to study at the University (when you fulfil certain conditions). Please note that you must provide satisfactory evidence that you have met these conditions prior to starting the course by forwarding to the University the relevant results or documents. Full details of the conditions are explained in the offer letter

An **unconditional offer** means that you have met all the academic requirements set by the University. However, you will need to provide the original academic transcripts and certificates during the registration day for verification purpose.

Important Note: If your application is successful, you will be able to download your offer letter from MyNottingham. You will need to click on the link in the offer letter to download information related to your offer and registration. No hard copies will be provided. Please print out a copy of the offer letter for registration, visa or scholarship application purposes.

Accepting your place

Once you have decided to study at the University of Nottingham Malaysia, you will need to formally accept your offer for a place within the *specified deadline.

In order to accept your offer, you will need to do the following:

- Remit the tuition fee deposit of RM1,000 (Malaysian offer holders) or RM2,000 (International offer holders). The tuition fee deposit will be off-set from the first semester's tuition fee.
- 2. Accept your offer to study by clicking on the accept/decline link under the 'Applications' tab in MyNottingham and proceed to make the tuition fee deposit online or email the proof of payment for the tuition fee deposit (if payment is not made through the online portal) to the Finance Office.
- 3. If you are being sponsored by your Government or any organisation, you will need to email the letter confirming your full sponsorship details before the offer lapse date to the Admissions Office and Sponsorship Unit. Once you have received a confirmation from the Sponsorship Unit, you will be able to accept your offer through MyNottingham.

*Specified deadline – students will normally be given a 4-week deadline. However, please refer to the due date stated in the course deposit checklist on MyNottingham or your offer letter for the exact date.

Remember – you must either make the tuition fee deposit through MyNottingham or send a proof of payment (if payment is not made through the online portal) to the Finance Office. Your offer will automatically lapsed after the specific deadline. If you are fully sponsored applicants, please send the evidence of sponsorship to the Admissions Office and Sponsorship Unit before accepting the offer.

More about the tuition fee deposit

What if I don't pay the deposit within the specified period?

If you failed to accept your offer and make the payment of the tuition fee deposit within the specified period, your offer for a place will automatically lapse.

A lapsed offer can be re-activated by paying the reactivation processing fee of RM150 for Malaysian applicants or RM200 for International applicants.

Do I have to pay the tuition fee deposit if I am a sponsored student?

Government or organisation sponsored offer holders are exempted from paying this fee when they provide a letter which confirms their full sponsorship details before the offer lapse date. Offer holders who receive partial funding (less than 100% of the tuition fee) are still required to pay the tuition fee deposit.

The proof of the funding must be provided to the Admissions Office and Sponsorship Unit before the lapse date or else you are obliged to pay the tuition fee deposit together with the reactivation fee.

If the deposit has been made earlier, it will be refunded to you once you have registered and the University receives evidence of full funding for your studies.

Will I get a refund if I can't come to the **University?**

The University will refund the tuition fee deposit (minus administrative fee) in the following circumstances:

Malaysian Offer Holders – Tuition Fee Deposit (less RM150 administrative fee) will be refunded if you have a conditional offer but fail to satisfy the academic conditions.

International Offer Holders - Tuition Fee Deposit (less RM200 administrative fee) will be refunded if you have a conditional offer but fail to satisfy the academic conditions.

The deposit is non-refundable in any other circumstances and the request for the refund must be made within one (1) academic year. Please note that any refund of the tuition fee deposit will only be considered once you have obtained a letter of rejection from the University.

For us to be able to process your refund, please submit the 'Refund of Tuition Fee Deposit Form' which you can download from the offer acceptance webpage:

How do I reactivate my lapsed offer?

If your offer has lapsed after the 4-week deadline, you will need to reactivate the offer by paying the reactivation processing fee of RM150 for Malaysian applicants or RM200 for international applicants. You will need to send an email to the Admissions Office together with the Reactivation of Lapsed Offer Form and the proof of payment of the reactivation fee.

However, please be advised that the University may not be able to guarantee you another offer if the programme which you have applied for earlier has reached its maximum quota.

Deferment of an offer

Applicants deferring from one academic year to another will be required to pay the tuition fee deposit before their deferral can be processed.

In addition to the tuition fee deposit, applicants are required to pay the deferment fee of RM50 for (Malaysian applicants) and RM100 for (International applicants).

entering the country. Conversion of an existing
Social Pass to Student Visa is strictly not
allowed.

University Registration

Provided that you have received and completed the admissions acceptance process, the University will be sending you further information regarding registration approximately four (4) weeks prior to the registration day.

University of Nottingham Malaysia requires all offer holders to complete two different parts of the registration process – Part 1: Online Registration and Part 2: In Person Registration.

You are required to complete the Online Registration and make the payment of tuition fees before the In Person Registration.

□ Payment of Tuition fees:

All students are required to pay the tuition fees during the Online Registration.

During In Person Registration, you are required to provide the following documents to the University:

☐ Registration documents:

- ✓ One (1) copy of Unconditional Offer Letter
- ✓ Original NRIC for Malaysian Offer Holders
- ✓ Original passport for international offer holders
- ✓ Original certificates and transcripts of academic qualifications (for verification)
- ✓ Proof of payment of tuition fee
- ✓ Scholarship/Sponsorship Letter (if applicable)

☐ Visa Approval Letter for international offer holders

International offer holders will be asked to provide a copy of your valid Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) or other valid passes before you are allowed to complete the In Person Registration with the University. The University will not be liable for any action taken by the Malaysian Immigration Authorities if you decided to ignore the regulation above.

Once you have completed the two (2) steps registration process and paid your fees, you are enrolled with the University and you will be able to collect your student identity card, which gives you access to the campus and its facilities.

Please NOTE that you will not be able to proceed with the In Person Registration without first completing the Online Registration process.

Additional important information for offer holders

The information below relates to a specific group of students. It is advisable for you to read carefully and to contact the relevant departments if you have any further enquiries.

General Studies – Undergraduate students

(Malaysian and International students nationals) are required to enrol, undertake, complete and pass all required stages of the General Studies Department modules (formerly known Compulsory Subjects) graduation. This is a precondition for the award of certificates, diplomas and degrees in Private Educational Institutions (PEI) and Private Higher Educational Institutions (PHEI) under the Private Higher Education Act 1996. This regulation come into effect from 1 September 2013 based on the Department of Higher Education, Ministry of Education Malaysia Administrative Circular JPT/ GS1000-606 JLD.1 (30) dated 22 July 2013.
