## **Accepting your place**

Applicants must pay the deposit in order to accept offers (either conditional or unconditional) for taught degree courses. Offer holders will normally be given a 4-week deadline to accept their offers and these dates are shown in the course deposit checklist and printed in the offer letter.

The tuition fee deposit is an advance payment to the University in order to secure a place on all our taught degree courses. You can read further on our refund policy in our <u>offer acceptance</u> page.

International applicants who require a student visa will need to pay the tuition fee deposit before applying for their visas.

## Extending your tuition fee deposit deadline

The University is providing a further **4-week extension** to all offer holders for **taught degree courses**. This extension will be printed in the offer letter (i.e. 8-week deadline) and is only applicable to (applications submitted together with the payment of application fees) from **21 April 2020 to 31 May 2020**.

For offers issued before 21 April 2020, offer holders will be notified in writing by the Admissions Office that the due date to pay the tuition fee deposit has now been extended to another 4-week.

This extension is not applicable to late applicants i.e. when the registration date or visa application deadline is approaching. We may provide an earlier deadline for late applications.

All extensions provided are final and no further appeals will be entertained.
