We are aware that exams and assessments are being impacted across the world due to the current outbreak of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19).

IGCSE, AS and A level and IB Diploma

Exam Boards have announced that they would take steps to award grades to candidates. This means ensuring that students are awarded grades, which fairly reflects the work they have put in.

Other international exams

We are aware that changes have also been made to other exams and result reporting other than the above. Our International Student Recruitment Team is working closely with our official overseas representatives to keep us updated.

Considering your results

The University will consider grades awarded by official awarding bodies and will treat them as equal status to previous years.

We have a well-established process in place to consider candidates who have not met the conditions of their offer once results are released. Applicants who have missed the terms of their offer will not automatically be unsuccessful. We will look closely at the results and make a decision.

Providing evidence of your qualifications

Exam Boards are planning to release results as planned.

- It is your responsibility to send copies of your certificates and transcripts to us. You can upload your results via your <u>MyNottingham</u> account.
- IB graduates can make a request to IB for their transcripts to be sent to the respective institutions directly.
