YM Tengku Ahmad Rithauddeen Award Essay Writing Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. The guestion and criteria for this Award are:

Topic: Corruption: what does it mean to your generation? How can corruption, in your view, be reduced or eliminated in Malaysia?

Criteria:

- The submission should be between 1,500 to 2,000 words; •
- Must be an original piece of work; •
- Demonstrates a good understanding of the issues of corruption;
- Well-written and inspiring with a persuasive call to action on the issues;
- Demonstrates an understanding of the obstacles to those actions;
- Provides thoughtful suggestions; and
- May want to make references to the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in the writing.
- 2. The competition is open to all students aged 17 to 21 years of age (as of 31 December) 2019) in Malaysia. Submission must be by a single author.
- 3. The following prizes will be awarded:

First prize: RM 2,000.00 Second prize: RM 1,500.00 Third prize: RM 1,000.00

- 4. The winning submissions will be selected by a panel of judges from the University of Nottingham and the United Nations Association of Malaysia. The judges will also name for commendation 5 further entries.
- 5. Only one (1) entry per student is permitted.
- 6. Entries by previous winners of the competition will not be considered.
- 7. Entries to the competition must be unique (i.e. not published elsewhere or submitted to other essay competition) and original in content. Entries found to contain plagiarism will be disgualified. A bibliography acknowledging references to existing work is required.
- 8. Submission as well as a completed entry form signed by the author should be sent via e-mail (as attachment in word or pdf format) to UNAM_Awards@nottingham.edu.my.
- 9. The deadline for submission is **13 September 2019**, Friday.
