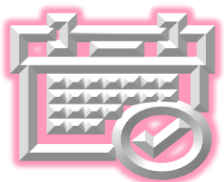

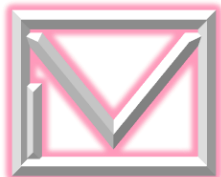

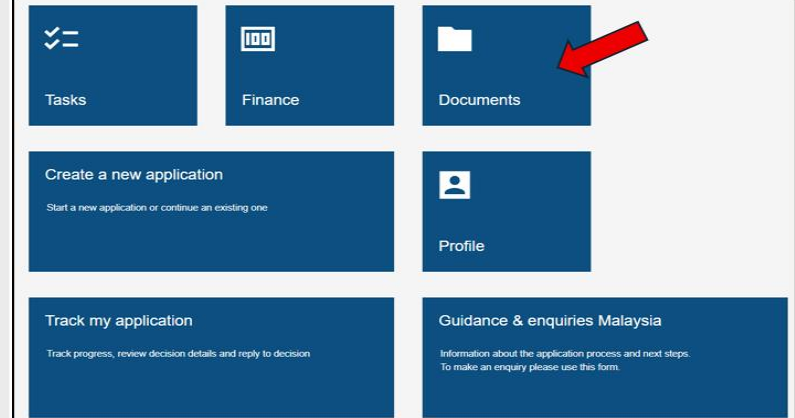

Verification of Documents

Conditions of admissions; the University's right to withdraw an offer of a place or terminate the registration of student.
