Creating Lasting Impact for Malaysia

UNM contributes to Malaysia's economy, talent development and innovation ecosystem.

- UNM's total economic impact over the past 10 years from 2015 – 2024 was estimated by backcasting the Gross Value-Added (GVA) for 2024 using a reverse growth model year by year. This method of estimation is commonly applied in economic modelling and forecasting, and adopted by organisations such as the World Bank and the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).
- GVA = direct GVA (economic output directly generated by UNM) + indirect GVA (economic output from supply chain) + induced GVA (economic output from spending by employees and vendors).

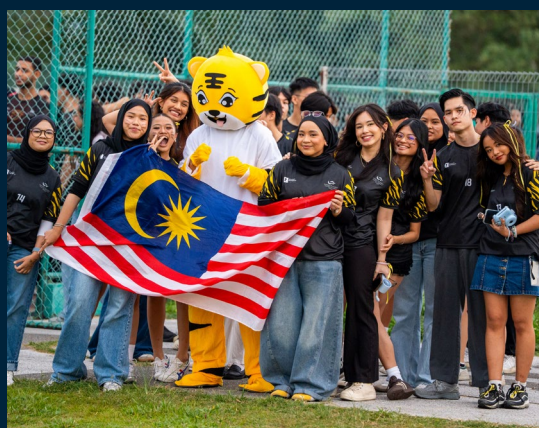
