

The Jan Atkin Prize

The Jan Atkin Prize was established by Professor Emeritus Brian Atkin in memory of his late wife, Jan. The prize aims to recognise students who have made notable contributions to the campus, students or local community. Students who are returning for a further year of study in the 2023/2024 academic year will be eligible to be nominated for this award.

The award

Three students will be selected each year to be awarded a prize of RM 5,000 each.

Eligibility criteria

- Students currently studying at the University of Nottingham Malaysia (UNM) and who are returning for at least one further year of study.
- Students who have made a notable contribution to the campus, students or local community.

Nomination and selection

1. Eligible students are those who have made notable contributions to the campus, students or local community.
2. Students must be nominated by a member of staff or a fellow student.
3. In the case of a student nominated by another student, a member of staff must second the nomination.
4. Nominees must complete and return the attached nomination form to [Alumni and Donor Relations Office](#), University of Nottingham Malaysia (UNM), no later than **5pm on 11 August 2023**.
5. Shortlisted nominations will be assessed by a panel from the University of Nottingham Malaysia (UNM) consisting of senior management, academic and professional services staff.
6. Nominees may be asked to provide evidence of claims made in their nomination form.
7. The University of Nottingham Malaysia (UNM) reserves the right to publicise the names of award recipients.
