

Tinggi-UNM MA Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

I. How do I apply for this scholarship?

Applicants can go to the University of Nottingham Malaysia's Scholarship webpage to download the application form.

II. When is the application deadline?

Refer to the information on the University of Nottingham Malaysia's Scholarship webpage.

III. My first degree is not education related. Can I apply for the scholarship?

Yes, you can. The Tinggi Foundation and University of Nottingham Malaysia are looking for candidates who are passionate about education.

IV. Do you accept provisional transcripts as I'm still waiting for my official transcript?

Yes. However, you need to submit your official transcripts to the University once they are available.

V. Can I work part-time while studying and working in the institution (IDEAS International Secondary School / IDEAS Autism Centre)?

The commitment to the institution is eight hours per day, three days per week. Scholarship holders also need to commit to their Master's degree studies. Thus, it is not advisable to seek any other part-time employment.

VI. Do I need to resign from my full-time job when I am offered the scholarship?

Yes, you must because you have to commit eight hours per day, three days per week to the institution.

VII. Can I complete my studies first before I work for the institution (IDEAS International Secondary School / IDEAS Autism Centre)?

No. You must begin your Master's studies at the same time you start working with the institution. The scholarship requires you to be enrolled in the selected Master's programme while concurrently fulfilling your responsibilities with the institution.

VIII. If I complete my studies in less than two years, do I still need to work for the institution (IDEAS International Secondary School / IDEAS Autism Centre) for two years?

Yes. The commitment to the institution is two years as part of the requirements of accepting the scholarship.
