

Tinggi-UNM MA Scholarship Frequently Asked Questions

I. How do I apply for this scholarship?

Applicants can go to the University of Nottingham Malaysia Scholarship webpage to download the application form.

II. When is the deadline of the application?

Refer to the information in the University of Nottingham Malaysia Scholarship webpage.

III. My first degree is not education related. Can I apply the scholarship? Yes, you can. The Tinggi Foundation and University of Nottingham Malaysia are looking for candidates who are passionate and committed about education.

IV. Do you accept provisional transcripts as I'm still waiting for my official transcript?

Yes. However, you need to submit your official transcripts to the University.

V. Can I work part-time while studying and working in the Academy? The commitment with the Academy is eight hours per day, and four days per week. Scholarship holders also need to commit to their Masters degree education. Thus, it is not advisable to seek any other part-time employment.

VI. Do I need to resign from my full-time job when I am offered the scholarship?

Yes, you must because you have to commit eight hours per day and four days per week to the academy.

VII. Can I complete my study first before I work for the Academy? No. You must enroll in the selected Masters programme when you accept the scholarship. The duration of part-time Masters is two years.

VIII. If I complete my study less than two years, do I still need to work for the Academy for two years?

Yes. The commitment to the Academy is two years as part of the requirements of accepting the scholarship.
