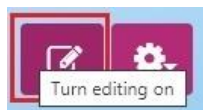


## How to add your Reading List to the main part of your Moodle page

In your module:



1. **Turn Editing On** using the icon on the top right.
2. Near where you want the reading list, click on the **Add an activity or resource**
