NUsearch trainings for library users

The Library will be conducting NUsearch training via Microsoft Teams for all students. New students are encouraged to attend the session to learn on how to access library resources. The training information and registration link can be found in library website.

NUsearch basic (30 minutes) sessions include:

- finding library books and eBooks
- how to request for on-loan books
- how to make a meeting-room booking
- managing your library account
- introducing the library's website and user guides

NUsearch advanced (60 minutes) sessions include:

- finding library books
- finding eResources (including, eBook, article, journal and databases)
- introducing BrowZine (a platform to access eJournals in one simple interface)
- how to request for on-loan books
- how to make a meeting-room booking
- managing your library account
- how to access past-exam papers
- introducing the library's website and user guides

Introduction to Bibliographic Software (EndNote / Mendeley) (60 minutes)

Hands-on introduction tutorial via Microsoft Teams that shows you on how to organise your references by using bibliographic software, i.e. EndNote or Mendeley.
